1.2. Price Bid (COVER – II)

To be super scribed prominently with "**Price Bid" for** "1169 dated 23.04.2022 Due on 07.05.2022 at 1100 Hours" and name, address, contact details of bidder should be mentioned and must contain the details as follows:

Bidders should submit the rates of each item listed in scope of work along with the complete details of applicable GST rates & GST Registration No as per Annexure—3 (Price Bids).

1.3 Additional Condition

- I. Rates for all items must cover the cost of all appropriate materials, labour, machinery, scaffolding, tools and plants and all appliances what so ever necessary for the complete execution of the work.
- II. Before commencement of work, contractors are required to fill up and get approval of "work permit" for working at height from competent authorities on daily basis. This is mandatory requirement when workers are working at height more than 5 feet from floor level.
- III. Every activity in connection with the subject work shall be carried out necessarily with the prior permission of EIC or his representatives.

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- IV. Contractors are required to procure adequate numbers of safety harness, helmets etc. duly approved by EIC before commencement of work at his own cost.
- V. Debris to be dumped at designated places only, at the end of the day's work. You will not be allowed to dump near the work in progress. If you will not be able to remove the debris within 7days out of AI AIR PORT SERVICES LIMITED premises, same will be carried out by AI AIRPORT SERVICES LIMITED at your risk and cost. The amount will be recovered from your bill towards the expenses incurred by AI AIRPORT SERVICES LIMITED to do the same.
- VI. Contractors may please note that in case of deviation in the item or use of materials other than specified under instructions of EIC (Allowed due to non-availability or otherwise) same shall be dealt in rates as under: "Difference in the cost of materials specified and actually used including taxes plus 20% overhead & profits (on the difference in cost of materials) shall be deducted from quoted rates in case of used material cost is lower than specified.
- VII. Necessary entry passes for contractor's workers shall be borne by selected contractor. Assistance will be provide by AIASL. However, these workers shall be controlled by a full-time and responsible supervisor employed by the contractor. They should confine to their own work area and shall not roam about or meddle with any equipment, material belonging to AI AIRPORT SERVICES LIMITED Ltd.
- VIII. It is necessary that the contractor maintains standard force and will take instructions from the In-Charge of AI AIRPORT SERVICES LIMITED. The work shall be planned and executed in consultation and co-ordination with the User Department. The contractor's supervisor shall meet the In-Charge everyday and inform him about the commencement and progress of work & shall be present throughout whenever the staff are working on the scaffolding & shall ensure that all safety harnesses, Belts, Helmets, are worn by all workers working on the scaffolding.
 - IX. No Repair work on heights and over scaffolding on External surfaces will be permitted if the site Supervisor / Engineer of Contractor is not available at place of work.
 - X. The quantities given in the schedule should not be considered to be precise and are merely as a guide to the tenders and are liable to vary according to the exigencies of work.
 - XI. Power supply: The power supply will be supplied by AI AIRPORT SERVICES LIMITED to the extent & capacity available at or near the site of work. However, the Contractor shall make own arrangements for the connecting cables, switch boards etc laying to the requirement. Contractors are advised to visit the site of work before quoting so as to be familiar with the site conditions.
- XII. Before the commencement of work clearance will have to be obtained from the Users / occupants and EIC of the work and the work shall be carried out with the concurrence of EIC.
- XIII. Prior approval of the EIC shall be taken by the Contractor for all the materials to be used in the work before execution and every activity connected with the work shall be carried out necessarily with prior permission of EIC or his authorised representative.
- XIV. The contractor shall obtain requisite Insurance policies like Workmen Compensation policy and / or CAR Policy for all his workmen at site & shall cover for full period of contract and for authorised extensions, if any, and shall be valid up to Defects Liability Period of One year. The responsibility for compensating contractor's workers will be solely borne by contractor.

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1.4 SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

- i. The contractor shall remove from the premises their employees who are found to be failing in his/their duties for whose presence in the premises is otherwise objectionable in the opinion of the AIASL representatives /Security staff / MIAL / CISF.
- ii. It is suggested that the intending bidder / bidders or their representatives should visit the various areas to study the details and nature of services to be rendered before sending their quotations. The contractor will be deemed to have satisfied themselves as to the nature and the area of work, local facilities of access and all matters and things in any way affecting their rendering services as per the agreement including Security requirements. No claims for extra charges shall be entertained in this behalf for any reason whatsoever.
- iii. The Contractor shall not enter into any sub-contract, without the prior written consent of the Competent Authority.

2. TENDER SUBMISSION

3. **DEFINITIONS**

In this contract, the following terms shall be interpreted as indicated.

- a) "Contract" means the agreement entered into between the Purchaser and the Contractor, as recorded in the contract form signed by the parties including all annexure thereto and appendices therein.
- b) "Spares" or "Items" shall mean all of the materials including their accessories and / or other materials, which the Tenderer is required to supply for repair the Pallet Dollies of AIASL under the contract.
- c) "Purchaser" or "Buyer" or "Owner" means AI Airport Services Limited (AIASL).,
- d) "Tenderer" or "Seller" or "Bidder" means the individual or firm or company, who are manufacturers / repairers / fabricators / suppliers, on whom the order for work is placed and shall be deemed to include their approved successors, heirs ,executors and administrators, holding company, Group, Group Companies, Conglomerate as the case may be.
- e) "AIASL representative" means the authorized representative of the Purchaser.
- f) "Manufacturer" means original material manufacturer (OEM). "Vendor" means contractor / supplier / bidder.

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4. TENDER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

4.1. SCOPE OF TENDER AND OBLIGATIONS:

(Confirmation on compliance on following points to be submitted with Technical Bid)

a) The Tenderer should ensure that:

- i. The Tender document should be neatly typed or neatly hand written and signed on numbered pages filed in binding folder. Two separate sealed envelopes i.e. one for Technical Bid & other for Price Bid should be submitted.
- ii. Corrections/over writing, if any, should be duly authenticated with full signature of the person who is signing the tender (**initials will not be accepted**).
- iii. Attached documentary proof in binding folder should be indexed chronologically, labeled and countersigned.

Non compliance to any of the above shall be liable for tender rejection.

- a. Tenders received late, delivered at different address other than as specified in the tender/ or lost in transit will not be considered irrespective of whether the delay has arisen on account of the delivery system, i.e. postal, courier etc.
- b. Tenders received through fax and / or email will not be considered.
- c. Tenders that are incomplete are liable to be rejected.
- d. On the date of opening of the technical bids, the "PRICE BIDS" would be kept in the custody of AI Airport Services Ltd. in sealed condition as received from tenderer. Representatives of the bidder can attend the technical bid openings.
- e. The Price bids of only those tenderers, who qualify in the Technical Bid evaluation, would be opened at a later date which will be intimated to technically qualified bidders, in advance. Representatives of the bidder can attend the price bid openings.
- f. If any indication of price is included in the Technical bid, the Bid will be rejected without reference to the tenderer. No correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
- g. Validity of Quotes: The Price quoted should remain valid for acceptance for a minimum period of 120 days from the date of opening of the tender.
- h. AI Airport Services Limited, reserves the right to accept or reject any or all offers without assigning any reasons.
- i. The successful tenderer shall undertake repairs job at premises of AI Air Transport Services Limited at respective Airports as per terms of the tender.

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- j. AI Airport Services Limited has the right to reduce / increase the quantity of material / items without any increase in unit price during the course of tender and delivery period, based on the future requirement, the delivery location may be subject to change.
- k. The successful tenderer shall supply the spares and material and perform the Repairs Work as per agreed rates:
 - I. in accordance with the Specifications.
 - II. in accordance with the Delivery Schedule;
 - III. in accordance with the best industry practice, diligently, efficiently, in a timely manner with reasonable care and skill to be expected of a reputable supplier experienced in the type of work to be carried out under the tender.
- 1. In the event of default, AIASL reserves the right to cancel the order and can claim damages from successful tenderer and also reserve the right to award the contract to another party at the cost and risk of the successful tenderer.
- m. Intention to Quote: You are requested to confirm your intention to quote / regret by email to the buyer.
- n. Any modification / alteration of the original Tender by the Bidder shall lead to disqualification.

4.2. COMMERCIAL TERMS

(Confirmation on compliance on following points to be submitted with Technical Bid)

4.2.1. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD): Non Compliance on EMD terms will lead to disqualification.

Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)

- (c) EMD in respect of the successful bidders will be refunded after receipt of Security Deposit.
- (d) EMD of unsuccessful bidders will be refunded after opening of Price Bids.
- (e) EMD will be forfeited in the event of a bidder withdrawing or modifying his bid after opening of the tenders and till completion of the tender process, i.e. till award of the contract, and / or in the event of the bidder, who has been awarded the contract, declining to honor the same.
- (f) EMD will be accepted only in Indian Rupees. EMD in any other currency will not be accepted.
- (g) MSME / SSI units registered with the NSIC under its Single Point Registration Scheme / Public Sector Units / Central / State Government undertakings / A-I widows Associations / A-I Co-Operative Society / Handicraft Boards, Khadi Village and Cottage Industries / Social Welfare Organizations / Handicapped and Blind Associations will be exempted from submission of EMD.

4.2.2. Payment terms: (Non acceptance by the Bidder on Payment terms will lead to disqualification):

4.2.3. Security Deposit (SD) / Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG): Non Compliance on SD / PBG terms, as below will lead to disqualification:

The bidder who qualifies for award of PO will have to deposit with AIASL 5% of the total value on basic price in the Purchase Order towards interest free Security Deposit, within 2 weeks of the receipt of the Purchase Order. Applicable Security Deposit / Performance Bank Guarantee will be in the form of Bank

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Guarantee/Demand Draft or Bankers Cheque in favor of 'AI AIRPORT SERVICES LIMITED', payable at MUMBAI.

In case of submission of Security Deposit / Performance Guarantee by means of Bank Guarantee / Demand Draft or Bankers Cheque, it may be noted that the original BG has to be forwarded by the Bank directly to AI Airport Services Ltd. through registered AD. The expense incurred towards submission of Security Deposit / Performance Bank Guarantee will have to be borne by the successful bidder.

Bank Guarantee or Demand Draft or Pay order will be refunded after 60 days of scheduled completion of entire job as per contract, submission of quality assurance certificate and completion of all obligations under the Purchase Order. In case of Bank Guarantee, same should be issued through any Indian Bank as per guidelines by RBI.

MSME / SSI units registered with the NSIC under its Single Point Registration Scheme / A-I widows Associations / A-I Co-Operative Society / Handicraft Boards, Khadi Village and Cottage Industries / Social Welfare Organizations / Handicapped and Blind Associations will be exempted from submission of Security Deposit.

- **4.2.4. DELIVERY SCHEDULE:** The successful bidder should complete all the formalities such as entry passes etc for their workers and commence the job within 7 calendar days from the date of receipt of PO and should be completed within 15-20 days so as to ensure that the job is completed before beginning of monsoon season.
- **4.2.5. Warranty:** The service provider shall give warranty of 6 months for the spares/material used and workmanship. In case of defect noticed during this period, it shall be responsibility of the service provider to carry such rectification/repairs on FOC basis.
- **4.2.6. Penalty Clause:** (Non Compliance on Penalty clause terms will lead to disqualification): For the delayed deliveries a penalty of 0.5% per week or part thereof of the value of the undelivered portion of the goods on ex works price or undelivered contract value, subject to a maximum of 10% of the value of the undelivered part, will be recovered from security deposit or from amount due to Tenderer after due notification to Tenderer.

AIASL further reserves the right to cancel the Purchase Order on the event of delayed deliveries, and to issue a fresh order to any other source. AIASL will not be liable for any cost, obligations and claims incurred by the tenderer due to the cancellation.

- **4.2.6. Price Negotiation:** As our company policy does not permit post-tender negotiations, you are requested to submit your best quote at this stage itself. Post-tender negotiations will be in exceptional cases with the L1 bidder only.
- **4.2.7. Fall in Price:** Price should remain firm till the completion of the contract period. During the contract period, if for any reason there is a downward revision in prices, the successful bidder will be responsible for passing on the benefits to AIASL.
- **4.2.7. Exit/Termination:** The contract may be terminated under the following circumstances: In the event of unsatisfactory performance or breach of any of the clause of the contract during the contract period, contract shall be terminated with one month's advance notice.

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If there is change in requirement of AIASL, PO shall be cancelled with three months advance notice. Similarly, party shall also be at the liberty to terminate the contract by providing to AIASL 3 months written notice. In case the party serves termination notice before exhaustion of 40% of the contract value, they will be debarred from participating in immediate next tender for that particular item / contract.

- **4.2.9.** For any quality assurance certificate or any related issue, the Tenderer should respond within 48 Hours. Any un-attended complaint beyond 10 days, in a half year due to Bidders late response shall attract a penalty of 0.5% per week and the same will be recovered from the pending invoices or from SD/PBG. Depleted amount with regard to SD/PBG need to be topped up within fifteen days by the tenderer.
- **4.2.10. Firm Price:** Price should remain firm till the fulfillment of PO liabilities.
- **4.2.11. Arbitration:** Any dispute arising between the parties of the construction, interpretation, application, meaning, operation or effect of this document or the validity or breach thereof, shall first be settled by mutual consultation. If dispute remains unresolved after period of 30 days from the date the mutual consultation has started, the matter shall be referred for settlement to 'SCOPE FORUM OF CONCILIATION AND ARBITRATION', Govt. Of India, and the award in pursuance there of shall be binding on the parties.
- **4.2.12 Jurisdiction:** Any dispute whatsoever shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of Mumbai & /or Delhi.

4.3 TECHNICAL TERMS:

(Confirmation on compliance on following points to be submitted with Technical Bid)

- **4.3.1.** Quality Assurance Certificate: Along with every batch of repairs job, party should submit Quality Assurance Certificate (QAC) indicating that the job is carried out in conformity with the specifications given in the Purchase Order.
- **4.3.2. In house inspection:** AIASL reserves the right to inspect Repaired sheds at any stage before approving. In case, any deviation in quality is found at the time of supply, then the same will be rejected and should be rectified free of cost.

Non adherence of this clause may lead to cancellation of P.O and AIASL reserves the right to withhold the invoice for that job.

5. AWARD DECISION FOR L1

The Bidder whose net price (on common platform such as landed cost) works out to be the lowest will be determined as L1 for the tender and order will be placed on overall lowest quote basis. However, in exceptional circumstances, AIASL reserves the right to divide the PO among more than one bidder in the ratio of 60 % to L1 bidder and 40% to L2 bidder if L2 bidder agrees to match the L1 rates.

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6. TENDERERS REPRESENTATIONS, CONVENANTS & INDEMNITIES:-

The tenderer has examined the scope of the Specifications and all other documents, information and requirement of AIASL, and has satisfied itself as to the adequacy thereof for the performance of this Tender. It is the duty of the tenderer to draw to the attention of AIASL any errors, discrepancies or inaccuracies in the Specifications or such other documents which an experienced supplier of the material should reasonably have discovered.

7. PRE QUALIFICATION CRITERIA: Bidders are required to submit the documentary evidence as required under Annexure 2 attached herewith.

8. CLARIFICATIONS:-

Amendments and clarifications, if any, to this tender will be hosted on the website of. AIASL and the same will not be intimated to the tenderers individually.
